

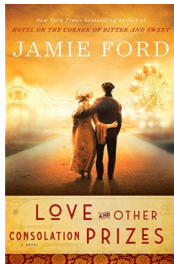

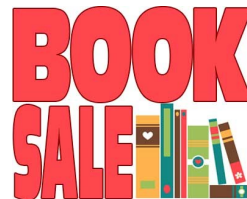
### Pardon Our Dust!

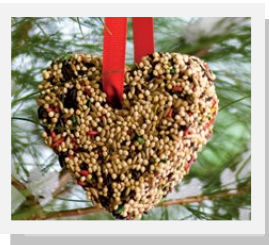
