

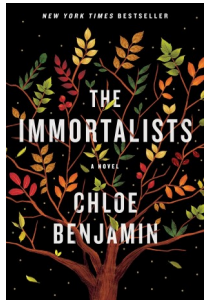

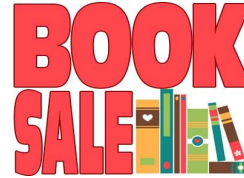


Adult Book Discussion

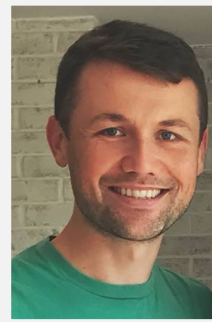

The Library Visits program (formerly the Sage Program) provides library services to older adults in Genesee County who are unable to visit the library. Library Visits is funded by a grant from the Muriel H. Marshall Fund for the Aging. A bequest from the estate of Roxanne Marshall, the fund is named in honor of her mother. Ms. Marshall, a former school librarian, wished to enhance the quality of life for older adults in Genesee County.

Residents of the county who are at least 60 years old and confined to their homes due to a short term or extended illness, disability, or lack of transportation may be eligible for the services of this program.

Library Visits also provides rotating mixed media collections to senior housing complexes, adult daycare facilities, nursing homes, and veterans facilities in Genesee County. *For more information contact the library at (585) 343-9550 ext. 6.*
